Part Three: Creating a Sacred Prayer Space

- Fabric should reflect Liturgical Year
 - o White/Gold
 - o Purple
 - o Red



Part Four: Steps to Creating a Prayer Service

- Select **focus** for your prayer service
- Choose a scripture passage which reflects this theme
- Select a symbol which represents your chosen scripture passage, and discuss how this symbol will be experienced by participants (ritual movement)
- Select **music** which supports overall theme of prayer service
 - o Pre-recorded music
 - o Live music
 - Singing
 - o Worship aid
- Write or select supporting prayer texts/poetry/meditation
- Build in time for silent reflection
- Build your **sacred space** around the symbol and scripture
 - Arrangement of chairs
 - o Placement of Ambo
 - o Chair for leader of prayer
 - o Lighting
 - o Focal point of prayer space
 - o Table for symbols/cloth
 - o Items needed for assembly's participation in ritual movement
