- 1. You do not need to know all of teens' music to use this approach; ask the teens to help you. What you need is to be open.
- 2. Form a team of youth music advisors.
- 3. Invite young people to bring in their own music for a music appreciation session.
- 4. Sponsor an inter-generational event; utilize ideologue, prayer and music from all the decades.
- 5. Become aware of the music preferences of the young people in your programs.
- 6. Lead an activity of searching the Scripture for references to music and inspiration for retreats and prayer services.
- 7. Sponsor a dance with positive values music; invite other churches.
- 8. Share with the young people your interest in music and your favorite songs as a teen; this will spark a great conversation.
- 9. Listen to the local teen radio station for 20 minutes once a week.
- 10. Enjoy, Enjoy, Enjoy. . . these are treasured moments.
