- I. Listen first to families rather than sending messages that don't resonate or motivate.
- 2. Focus on building relationships, rather than providing programs.
- 3. Highlight families' strengths, even amid challenges, rather than adopting approaches based on negative stereotypes.
- 4. Encourage families to experiment with new practices that fit their lives, rather than giving them expert advice on what they need to do.
- 5. Emphasize parenting as a relationship more than a set of techniques.
- 6. Broaden coalitions focused on young people's success in order to actively engage families.

- * develop healthy relationships
